INVESTIGATION:

On 5/5/10, I was assigned this case. During the previous night, the victim, Dodds, had sent a series of emails to Lt. Sellers claiming that [REDACTED] had put a web site up defaming Dodd and his business. [REDACTED] was demanding money before he would take down the site. These emails are attached.

At 1023, I was forwarded a voice mail from Lt. Sellers that he had received from [REDACTED]. In the message, [REDACTED] wanted to explain the situation.

At 1025, I took a recorded statement from Dodds. A transcript is attached. The following issues are raised in the statement:

1. Dodds changes his story back and forth regarding the work that [REDACTED] actually performed or failed to perform. He states that [REDACTED] fixed it, then PayPal tech support fixed it, then he claimed he had to hire another programmer at \$100.00 an hour to fix it. He could not provide the name of the other programmer. When confronted with the contradictions, Dodds changes the subject.
2. Dodds stated he put \$90.00 into PayPal to pay [REDACTED] but it was never claimed.
3. There was never a written contract regarding payment or expected results.
4. Dodds claims that [REDACTED] only had to change a couple lines of code. He then makes statements about fixing the check out program. He could not explain the required work to me.
5. Dodds claims that [REDACTED] agreed to \$60.00 flat fee. [REDACTED] later told him it was \$30.00 an hour and billed him for seven hours totaling \$210.00. The price went up to \$1,000.00 after the website. Dodds stated that [REDACTED] "tried to get me for \$7,500."
6. Dodds made the statement, "I haven't spoken to him since I, this website, since I found the website, you know. I haven't really. I have not contacted this guy."
7. Dodds makes statements that [REDACTED] could be a member of cult and that he feared for the safety of his family. When I asked if [REDACTED] had made any specific threats or statements that would cause him to believe this, Dodds would only make general references to "those people."
8. Dodds believes that [REDACTED] has hacked into his computer and is altering his files and programs and stealing email from his system. I asked if other people could have forwarded the emails and Dodds replied, "Maybe. That could possibly happen. He stated that he knows [REDACTED] has "hacked" into his computer since there is a delay between his keystrokes and the monitor so "there is a keystroke logging program on or a image capture program."


Dodds promised to forward me emails that proved his case. He sent me the two attached emails.

At 1156 I took a recorded statement from [REDACTED] over the phone. A transcript is attached. The following issues were raised in his statement:

1. Again, no contract was written prior to the work. [REDACTED] said the agreed upon price was \$30.00 per hour and he "fixed some significant bugs."
2. [REDACTED] knew about the PayPal amounts but did not claim them as it wasn't the full amount of \$210.00.
3. [REDACTED] stated that after he put up the site to warn other people, Dodds contacted him and wanted to buy the site. [REDACTED] made up the price of \$1,000.00. We discussed how much work he actually performed and could only justify 12 hours at \$30.00 per hour for a total of \$360.00. The remaining \$640.00 was in addition to the original bill.

[REDACTED] promised to send me all the emails he had regarding his business transactions with Dodds. He sent me sixteen emails, some containing email threads with up to ten messages back and forth between the two of them. In one thread, [REDACTED] proposes hosting Dodd's website for a percentage and \$7500. There did not appear to be an


extortion attempt for that amount. There was also extensive communication between [REDACTED] and Dodds reference various options for Dodd's business website. The communications indicated there was far more that "two lines of code" involved in their transactions.

I looked at the website that [REDACTED] posted titled www.johnathandodds.com. It resembled any other consumer awareness site. All the emails that [REDACTED] had sent me were posted as well as two "professional" profiles that Dodd's had posted and [REDACTED] had linked.

At 1303, I called Dodds and recorded our conversation. When I asked him if he had contacted [REDACTED] regarding the site, he said he had and admitted to sending the attached email which states, "You win. How much money do you want to take down the web site you posted about me." This contradicts his previous statement, which contradicted itself. I asked about his negotiations regarding the \$7500 and he claimed he negotiated because he wanted to keep [REDACTED] from "going postal." Again he could offer no reason for fearing physical harm from [REDACTED] other than general comments about "those people." I informed him I was closing the case and he could seek civil recourse if he desired. He was not happy.

Given Dodd's initial offer to buy the site rather than [REDACTED] soliciting payment, there was no extortion attempt. Given Dodd's deception, there is no credible complaint of a crime.
